with substantial financial investments, with over 500 million Naira dedicated to enhancing the lives of individuals and communities. This investment has been utilised for 132 projects and social interventions in 150 communities across 29 states within a year.

Moving forward, the Foundation aims increase its investment in Nigerian communities. This heightened commitment will have a significant impact on Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) aspects, further demonstrating its dedication to sustainable development and positive social change. As we mark one year since our official establishment, Bet9ja Foundation remains unwavering in its mission to create a lasting, positive impact on the lives of those we serve.



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Situation Analysis

Global youth unemployment hits 13.44%, International Labour Organisation reports.

The statistics are concerning, but there is a glimmer of hope. According to a 2023 report by the International Labour Organisation (ILO), youth unemployment in Nigeria has decreased by 0.3% compared to previous years. Despite this improvement, Nigeria still faces significant challenges in key sectors such as healthcare, education, infrastructure, and sports development, which are essential for national growth and citizen well-being.

The World Health Organisation categorises Nigeria as one of the countries with the highest maternal mortality rates, with approximately 512 deaths per 100,000 live births as of 2019. The healthcare sector is a major concern, especially as the Nigerian population continues to grow. Many rural communities still lack basic amenities such as clean water, reliable electricity, and proper

roads, which worsen health issues. The education sector is also a cause for concern. According to UNESCO, about 10.5 million children are out of school in Nigeria, one of the highest numbers in the world. Low-income households invest little to no resources in their children's education, while those who can afford it seek better opportunities abroad. This brain drain stifles the country's intellectual and professional growth.

Furthermore, infrastructure development is another area of concern. Inadequate roads, unreliable electricity, and poor water supply hinder economic activities and the overall quality of life. Improving infrastructure is vital for economic development and attracting foreign investment. Also, despite global optimism about the sports industry, especially in emerging areas like women's sports, Nigeria's



sports development suffers from chronic underfunding and poor management.

This lack of support prevents young athletes from reaching their full potential and stifles the overall growth of sports in the country. These critical challenges are not insurmountable.

Bet9ja Foundation aims to address these issues through its five pillars, with concerted efforts and strategic investments. Nigeria can overcome these challenges and pave the way for a brighter future for its citizens.

Bet9ja Foundation Hosts Young Executive Program (YEP)

Recognising the significant need for skill development and employment among Nigerian youth, Bet9ja Foundation has launched the Young Executive Program (YEP). The program offers a dynamic and intensive three-month learning experience aimed at equipping young graduates with essential workplace skills. Bet9ja is traditionally known for sports related initiatives, yet it has expanded its efforts to present programmes that aim to empower the youth including the recent YEP.

In the 3rd quarter of 2023,

Bet9ja Foundation initiated the YEP to address the high unemployment rates among Nigerian youths and to promote greater economic empowerment in local communities.

The programme took place across Lagos, Benin, Abuja, and Enugu, targeting 200 young Nigerians aged 21-30, or 21-35 for those with disabilities. Throughout the masterclass, participants engaged in comprehensive modules designed to prepare them for professional challenges and opportunities. The YEP

focused on entrepreneurship, employability, and leadership to bridge the gap between education and employment. Participants gained valuable resources, mentorship, and networking opportunities, significantly boosting their career prospects. Bet9ja Foundation's dedication to skill empowerment through YEP aims to address unemployment and promote sustainable development in Nigeria. This underlines the ongoing efforts to empower youths and create lasting positive change in their communities.





GEES2024

Bet9ja Foundation successfully hosted its Graduate Employability and Entrepreneurial Summit (GEES) 2024 on May 2nd at The Zone, Plot 9, Gbagada Industrial Scheme, Lagos.

The summit, themed "Navigating the Future: Building Employability and Entrepreneurial Success," fulfilled its mission to empower Nigerian youths by equipping recent graduates with crucial knowledge, skills, resources,

and networking opportunities essential for thriving in today's competitive job market.With a line-up of 10 distinguished speakers, the event provided attendees with valuable insights and practical advice on navigating career paths and entrepreneurial ventures. The summit not only aimed to enhance participants' employability but also to foster a spirit of entrepreneurship among young Nigerians, emphasising innovation and resilience in the face

of challenges. By bringing together a diverse audience, the GEES 2024 significantly raised awareness of Bet9ja Foundation's ongoing commitment to supporting the next generation of Nigerian professionals and entrepreneurs.

Through initiatives like GEES, the Foundation continues to play a pivotal role in empowering youths and contributing to the socioeconomic development of Nigeria.





Oyo State Empowerment Initiative in Ogbomoso (Q1 2024)

Bet9ja Foundation carried out an empowerment initiative in Ogbomoso, Oyo State, Nigeria. The main beneficiaries of this initiative were local traders, tailors who received sewing machines to enhance their capabilities, and engineers who were provided with toolboxes containing essential tools for their technical repair work.

Additionally, barbers were equipped with professional clippers to improve their grooming services, and hairdressers received blow dryers to enhance their hair styling services.





Ogun & Osun State (Q3 2023 - Q1 2024)

In collaboration with the Ogun State Government, we implemented a community infrastructure and healthcare initiative. This involved installing solar panel streetlights in Mowe and Ajegunle, as well as donating medical packages and items in Ota and Mowe.

Also, we provided medical materials to the Otubu Maternity in Modakeke and Oloomo Wewe in Ile-Ife, Osun state, including blood pressure monitors, glucometers, mattresses, pillows, hospital beds, and maternity kits. The beneficiaries mainly consisted of nursing mothers and some health workers.





South-East Zone Imo (Q3 & Q4 2023, Q1 2024)

An ICT and communication training, in partnership with Shekinah British International School, was successfully conducted to bridge the knowledge gap and empower students to compete effectively in the evolving technology era.

Furthermore, Bet9ja Foundation proudly organised a football match to support the Owerri grassroots football team, providing young athletes with the opportunity to showcase their talents through healthy competition, culminating in well-deserved prizes for the winners.

In addition, community infrastructure development was prioritised as the Foundation boldly constructed a borehole system to provide clean water accessibility, significantly improving the lives of the citizens.





Abia, Enugu & Anambra (Q1 2024)

conducting comprehensive needs assessment, we successfully identified the lack of quality eye care as a significant challenge in the state. Hence, the Foundation took decisive action by organizing a highly impactful two-day medical outreach program specifically focused on eye care. This program was strategically designed to target prevalent diseases such as glaucoma, short-sightedness, and long-sightedness. Similar health challenges were also identified in Enugu State, notably including a critical shortage of medical personnel.

As an organisation committed to making a difference, our robust medical programs efficiently addressed pressing needs such as HIV/ AIDS testing, blood pressure checks, malaria testing, general medical diagnoses, and the distribution of essential medical packages.

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Furthermore, in the spirit of promoting sportsmanship, Foundation Bet9ja successfully partnered with the Anambra State Football Association. Together, we orchestrated a highly engaging event, the Anambra Premier Cup 2023, at the prestigious Awka Stadium on October 29th. Notably, prizes amounting to 1 Million Naira, Five Hundred Thousand Naira, and Two- Hundred and Fifty Thousand Naira were rightfully awarded to the top 3 teams, respectively.

Moreover, our impactful efforts extended to executing vital infrastructural projects, such as the installation of 3-in-1 solar lights in the Anambra East and West Federal Constituency. This initiative truly served as a testament to our unwavering commitment to holistic community development and well-being.







North-West Zone Kaduna, Zamfara, Kano & Katsina (Q1 2024)

In the first quarter of 2024, the Foundation focused on addressing the scarcity of clean water in communities in Kaduna, Zamfara, Kano, and Katsina. An assessment revealed that the Angwan Doo community in Kaduna state lacked access to clean water. To address this issue, solarpowered boreholes were constructed in the community. A commissioning ceremony was held after the completion of the boreholes, and it was attended by community members and local leaders. In addition, community

members received education on hygiene and maintenance practices to ensure the sustainability of the facilities. Provision of clean water is one of the global goals and addressing the scarcity of clean water is crucial for communities in Kaduna state.

At Angwan Doo community, solar-powered boreholes were constructed, and the community members were educated on hygiene and maintenance practices to safeguard their facilities.







North - East Zone Bauchi, Gombe, Yobe, Taraba (Q1 2024, Q3 2023, Q4 2023)

A health study funded by USAID has identified Bauchi State as having a shortage of healthcare facilities, leading to an average ratio of 300 patients per doctor. These statistics indicate an urgent need for intervention.

To address this significant

gap, we targeted four specific local government areas (Gwalameji LGA, Tafawa Balewa LGA, Ningi LGA, and Azare in Katagum LGA) for an intensive medical outreach program called "Global Promoters for Community Initiatives".

During this program, residents received free health screenings, medications, and checks for blood pressure and blood sugar levels. Additionally, medical professionals conducted health education sessions to raise awareness.





Yobe (Q3 2023)

In Yobe State, our Foundation organised a sports event to bring together local communities and showcase sportsmanship. The match took place in an open field with members of the communities as spectators, and a prominent table for the judges. The match ended on a positive note, with players from both teams congratulating each other on a well-played game, demonstrating the true essence of sportsmanship.





Gombe (Q4 2023)

Our intervention project in Gombe State focused on healthcare, specifically addressing menstrual hygiene and wellness. Due to economic constraints, families struggle to provide basic hygiene products for females, impacting their well-being. To address this challenge, Bet9ja Foundation conducted a program aimed at educating women, which concluded with the provision of a substantial amount of reusable sanitary pads and other hygienic products.



Taraba (Q4 2023)

A breath of fresh air was experienced in Taraba State as our Foundation took on the distribution of essential commodities such as rice, beans, cooking oil, and other staples, providing muchneeded relief to families struggling with food insecurity. Additionally, the team on the ground distributed new

wheelchairs and crutches to the disabled, who went home with smiling faces. This was facilitated by community leaders and volunteers of Bet9ja Foundation to ensure transparency and accountability at every step.



North-Central Zone

Kogi State (Q4 2023)

In a 2021 MoneyCentral report, Kogi State was ranked low in business transactions. In response, our Foundation initiated a project to empower the old and young in Egbe community by providing them with milling machines. We also distributed branded parasols to essential goods traders at Lokongoma Market in Lokoja.

These initiatives were aimed at eradicating poverty and creating a more supportive environment for traders during their business activities. Additionally, Bet9ja Foundation installed a solar panel streetlight at the divisional police headquarters in Ayetoro-Gbede.



Benue State (Q4 2023)

The Food Basket of the Nation, Benue State, is known for its resilience and vibrant culture. We capitalized on this rich culture by organizing a board game called Draughts, fondly known as "Draft." This initiative aimed to promote community building while rewarding people for their hard work and passion.

Furthermore, we empowered the youths through an ICT skill acquisition program, providing laptops for participants. Infrastructure development was carried out through the construction and provision of a borehole and water storage tank.



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Abuja (Q3 2023)

Abuja State celebrated the spirit of sportsmanship as the Bet9ja Foundation recognised the importance of sports in fostering a vibrant community. The Foundation organised and solely sponsored an annual boxing and football competition.



South-South Zone

Akwa Ibom (Q1 2024)

A project called "Light Up UYO" was carried out in the Urban Local Government area of Akwa Ibom. This project involved donating, installing, and testing solar panel streetlights in the area. We provided a cost-effective and environmentally friendly lighting solution that will significantly improve the quality of life in the community.

Additionally, this has boosted economic and social activities and promoted environmental sustainability in Urban LGA.







Rivers Medical Outreach (Q1 2024)

Rivers State has faced healthcare access challenges, including a shortage of facilities, personnel, and essential services. To address these issues, the Bet9ja Foundation launched a targeted medical outreach, delivering vital healthcare services to underserved communities. The initiative provided routine health screenings, maternal and child care, vaccinations, and public health education.

In Port Harcourt, Bet9ja also organized a marathon to promote sports empowerment in a city historically lacking athletic recognition. The successful event attracted statewide participation, fostering community engagement and awarding cash prizes to top finishers. The presence of key stakeholders emphasized the event's positive impact on the community.



Delta Medical Outreach (Q4 2023)

In addition, Delta State benefited from our medical outreach. We identified communities with limited healthcare facilities and prioritized them for assistance. Working alongside local leaders, we distributed health kits, conducted blood pressure and sugar level checks, provided comprehensive health assessments, and educated residents on preventive healthcare measures.

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
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Cross Rivers Eye Care Outreach (Q4 2023)

The Cross River Eye Care Outreach was established to meet the urgent need for accessible eye care services in the region, where many residents have limited access to essential healthcare. The outreach program offered free eye examinations, and treatments, providing corrective lenses to those in need.

A team of skilled ophthalmologists and optometrists conducted thorough screenings for various eye conditions, including cataracts, glaucoma, and refractive errors, ensuring early detection and timely intervention. Additionally, eye care kits were distributed to reinforce the lessons learned during the outreach.
